



During the 2020 Pandemic, the trio successfully organised an August outdoor picnic concert in North Yorkshire, followed by a series of online events. They love connecting with their local communities, especially in North Yorkshire, where the trio began. Recently they curated a livestream event as part of the Helmsley Arts Centre's 'Connected and Creative Community' series, where the music was directed completely by visual artwork from the local community. They love working with composers, premiering a new trio written during the Pandemic by David Lancaster and have given composition workshops at York St John University. Future collaborations include performances with York Late Music, and premieres of new works by composers John Hawkins and Joseph Shaw.

They often provide a small twist to enhance this enjoyment, often in commissioned visual art. During the 2020 Pandemic, the trio successfully curated an outdoor picnic concert in August 2020, and an online Festive Concert for their followers.

Working closely with composers and other art-forms, Trilogy Ensemble aim to expand the music for this warm combination of instruments. In 2020, David Lancaster composed a new trio on the theme of isolation during lockdown. It will be premiered in March 2021 in a new collaboration with Helmsley Arts Centre, involving artwork from the local community. Future collaborations include workshops and performances with York St John University.

In collaboration with their performance, of Submerged by Miguel Aguila, a visual video art was created to portray the beauty and darkness of the sea, in contrast to the vast amount of plastic waste being polluted into the world's tropical paradises. We understand audiences' love for experiencing the music they know and love. We often provide a small twist to enhance this enjoyment, often in commissioned visual art or to our well-known local audiences - by introducing works they may not of encountered but that we believe they'll enjoy and will enhance their love of music. The trio regularly arrange different works for the trio combination, as well as commissioning composers to write brand new works.

Future collaborations include: the World Premiere of David Lancaster (composer's) new trio on 'isolation', written during the 2020 lockdown; a new collaboration with Helmsley Arts Centre, for a new community-based musical event in March 2021; workshops with student composers at York St John University.
